

2nd & 3rd Grade *Analogous* Shape & Line Animal.

I can make an animal using shapes, lines and analogous colors.

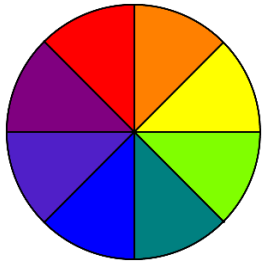
Below is an example of a finished Shape & Line Animal.

You will need paper, pencil, and crayons, markers or color pencils, black marker.

Week 1: The instructions are on page 2, you can draw an animal or print out the line drawing of a cat on page 3 to start. Notice how step 4 explains to draw some patterns(repeated shapes) in the bigger shapes that you created.

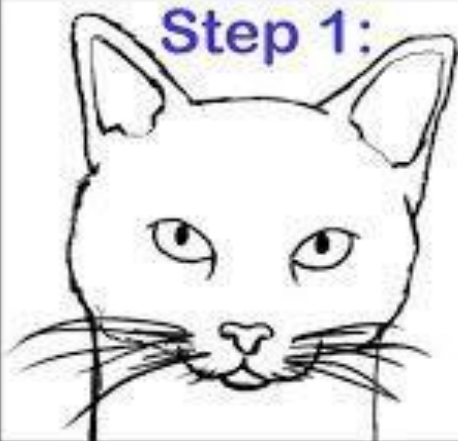
Week 2: Color your animal. Choose an ANALAGOUS color scheme. Analogous colors are those that are next to each other on the color wheel (usually 3 colors). The example shows yellow, green and blue. Another option would be red, orange and yellow. What would another option be?

Week 3: *I can use a color scheme to make a piece of art.* Use a different color scheme to create a drawing of your choice. Other color schemes are: Complementary colors, Cool colors or Warm colors. Look up the meaning of those schemes before you decide which one to use.



INSTRUCTIONS:

Step 1:

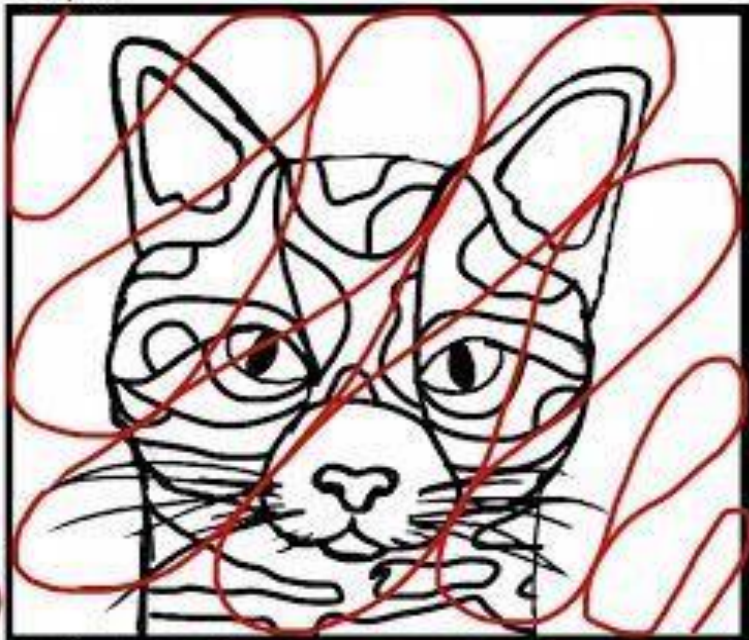


Using the Resource Images, make an outline drawing of the cat or the dog. Use a lead pencil. No shading. No details. Leave the background bare.

Page 1

Step 3:

With a lead pencil, draw a swirling line diagonally across the entire artwork, making sure the loops touch. This will create additional shapes.



Step 2:



On the animal's face, draw a variety of shapes. Do not make the shapes too small. For the above example, 22 lines were drawn to create 30+ shapes.



Step 4: Colour each shape using water-based markers (textas) or Sharpies. Some shapes should include a pattern.

Step 5: Using a black marker or Sharpie, trace **EVENLY** over all the lines created from Step 1, Step 2 and Step 3. Lines around the eyes should be made thicker as this will make them stand out.
