Make sure it is big and fat.

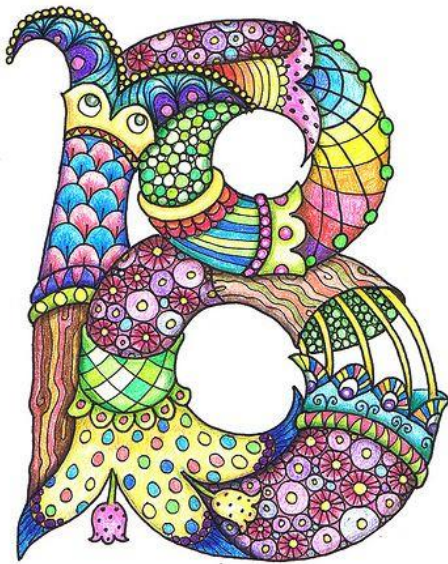
Add some curves and swerves to it if you want to fancy it up.
