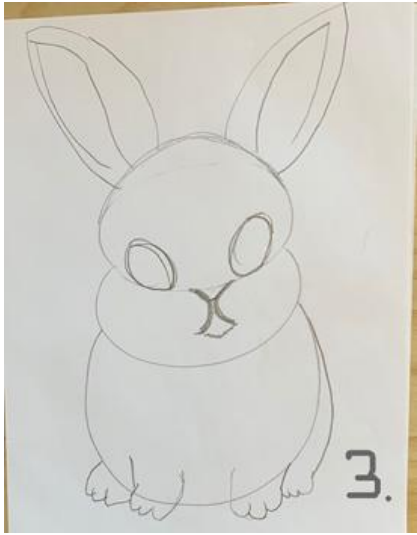
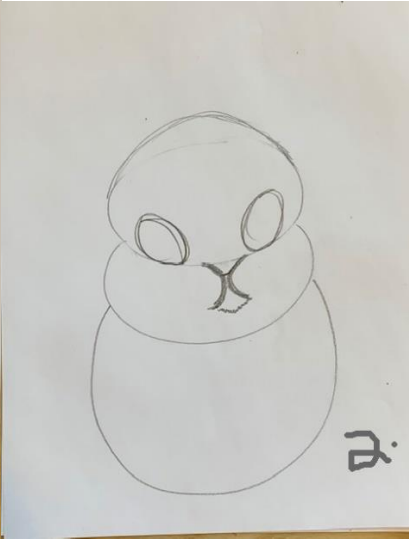
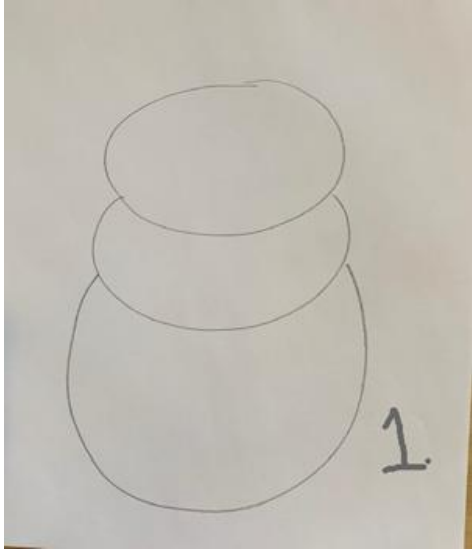




4th & 5th Grade Draw a Bunny

using basic shapes







Materials Needed: Paper, black pen, pencil, pink crayon

Directions:

The pictures show the steps. We have done drawings with basic shapes before so just think about shapes as you form the bunny and think about where details should be placed in relation to other shapes/details. For example, notice how big the eyes are and that they sort of in the middle of the head, not near the top. What else do you notice?

Your bunny does not have to look just like the example. Just do the best you can.

You might want to draw the body and face details in pencil in case you need to erase, then add the fur lines with the black pen. After all the fur is in place, use your pencil to

add some shading over the fur lines, just rub lightly using the side of the pencil.

Maybe you have thought of some extra details you want to add to make it even better. Add those touches, then add some color.
